By the substitution for the introductory wording of paragraph (a)(iv) of rule 18.08 and for subparagraph (aa) thereof of the following words and subparagraph:

- "(iv) in the Republic or to any other country in the common customs area or to any destination outside the common customs area—
- (aa) if the goods are carried by road, the customs code number and the name and address of the licensed remover of goods in bond must be inserted;"

Deur die inleidende woorde van paragraaf (a)(iv) in reël 18.08 en subparagraaf (aa) daarvan deur die volgende woorde en subparagraaf te vervang:

- "(iv) in die Republiek of enige ander land in die gemeenskaplike doeanegebied of na enige bestemming buite die gemeenskaplike doeanegebied—
- (aa) indien die goedere per pad vervoer word, moet die doeane-kodenummer en die naam en adres van die gelisensieerde vervoerder onder waarborg ingevoeg word;"
