**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964

**SCHEDULE**

By the substitution for paragraph (a) of rule 120B.01 of the following paragraph:

**"Temporary procedures in respect of goods carried by road on the Trans Kalahari Route:**

- 120B.01      (a)      The provisions of these rules only apply -
- (i)      from 1 February 2004 to 31 July 2004;
  - (ii)      in respect of goods carried by road on the Trans Kalahari Route; and
  - (iii)      to goods –
    - (aa)      entered by or consigned by a consignor as defined in rule 64D.03(1); or
    - (bb)      carried by a licensed remover of goods in bond as contemplated in section 64D;

where such persons are required by the General Manager: Customs to use and produce the SAD 500 referred to in rule 120B.02 for the carriage of such goods by road on the Trans Kalahari route."
