

**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964-
AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE NO. 2 (No. 2/85)**

Under section 56 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964 –

1. Part 1 of Schedule No. 2 to the said Act is hereby amended to the extent set out in the Schedule hereto;
2. this amendment, insofar as it relates to codes 05.06, 06.06 and 07.06 to tariff heading No. 3904.10, shall be deemed to have come into operation on **15 December 2000**.
