311.10/5407.20/02.06	<p>Provision is made for a rebate of the full duty on woven fabrics of a width exceeding 370 cm, obtained from strip or the like, of polymers of propylene, unprinted, for use as backing material in the manufacture of tufted carpeting in the length, having a width exceeding 360 cm in the loom state.</p>

Due to the imposition of a definitive anti-dumping duty on woven fabrics of synthetic staple fibres, containing acrylic fibres, imported from or originating in the People's Republic of China, **with retrospective effect to 25 June 2004**, the provisional payment called for in terms of Government Notice No. R.765 dated 25 June 2004, must be set off against the anti-dumping duty and the said Notice is withdrawn with immediate effect.

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
