Provision	Note
3907.60.90	The effect of this amendment is that provisional payments are imposed on poly(ethylene terephthalate) (excluding liquids and pastes thereof), originating in or imported from Taiwan, Province of China, India and the Republic of Korea.

**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964.-  
IMPOSITION OF PROVISIONAL PAYMENT (PP/120)**

Under section 57A of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, a provisional payment in relation to anti-dumping duty is imposed up to and including 7 April 2006 to the extent and on the goods set out in the Schedule hereto.
