

**NOTES REGARDING AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULES  
TO THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964**

**These notes are issued merely as a guide and both the old and new provisions should be studied in order to determine what the amendment actually entails. These notes have no legal status.**

<i>Provision</i>	<i>Note</i>
2915.33	The rates of duty on n-butyl acetate have been reduced from 15% (general) and 13,2% (EU) to free respectively.
311.12/4811.5/01.05	Provision is made for a rebate of the full duty on release paper, coated, impregnated or covered with silicone used as a carrier in the manufacture of spread coated textile fabrics of (vinyl chloride) of subheading 5903.10.
3901.20 3901.20.05 and 3901.20.90	The effect of this amendment is that the existing subheading 3901.20 has been amended to conform to the tariff structure in terms of the International Convention on the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (the Harmonised System).
