

**NOTES REGARDING AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULES
TO THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964**

These notes are issued merely as a guide and both the old and new provisions should be studied in order to determine what the amendment actually entails. These notes have no legal status.

2309.90.65	<p>Provisional payments are imposed in relation to anti-dumping duty on feed supplements, containing, by mass, 40 per cent or more lysine, whether or not containing added antibiotics or added melengestrol acetate –</p> <p>(a) of 34% - manufactured by or imported from Degussa Corporation; and</p> <p>(b) of 49% - manufactured by all other exporters, imported from or originating in the United States of America.</p>

**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964.-
IMPOSITION OF PROVISIONAL PAYMENT (VB/122)**

Under section 57A of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, a provisional payment in relation to anti-dumping duty is imposed up to and including **24 October 2006**, to the extent and on the goods set out in the Schedule hereto.
