206.01/28.03/04.04	The effect of this amendment is that the anti-dumping duty on carbon (carbon blacks and other forms of carbon not elsewhere specified or included), originating in or imported from the Republic of Korea, is withdrawn, <b>with retrospective effect to 10 September 2004.</b>
