215.11/8201.30/01.06	The effect of this amendment is that the anti-dumping duty on hoes, originating in or imported from China, is withdrawn, <b>with retrospective effect to 8 March 2007.</b>
241.14/6302.2/01.05 241.14/6302.3/01.05	The effect of this amendment is that the countervailing duty on printed and dyed bed linen, originating in or imported from Pakistan, is withdrawn, <b>with retrospective effect to 28 December 2006.</b>
