

**NOTES REGARDING AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULES
TO THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964**

14 SEPTEMBER 2007

These notes are issued merely as a guide and both the old and new provisions should be studied in order to determine what the amendment actually entails. These notes have no legal status.

2309.90.50	The effect of this amendment is that a new provision is created for calcium salts of palm fatty acid at a rate of duty of free.
307.03/4908.90/01.00	The effect of this amendment is that provision is made for a full rebate of duty on heat transfer labels (decalcomanias), not vitrifiable, for use in the manufacture of articles for the conveyance or packing of goods, of plastics classifiable in tariff heading 39.23.
316.09/8516.80/02.06 316.09/8516.90/02.06 316.09/8516.80/01.06	The effect of this amendment is that the rebate provision relating to electric heating resistors is amended to include jug kettles with bodies of plastic and new rebate provisions are inserted to make provision for glass lids, for the manufacture of electric frying pans of heading 85.16 and electric heating resistors with a rated heating capacity not exceeding 1 000 Watt, for the manufacture of single or double spiral-plate tabletop cookers of heading 85.16.
460.18/9018.31/01.06	The effect of this amendment is that a new temporary rebate provision is created for disposable hypodermic syringes of plastics, fitted with needles that, after use, are permanently retracted into the barrel of the syringe, at such times, in such quantities and under such conditions as the International Trade Administration Commission may allow by specific permit: provided that it was proven to the Commission that there are no manufacturers of such or similar safety syringes in the SACU area.
