

NOTES REGARDING AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULES
TO THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964

These notes are issued merely as a guide and both the old and new provisions should be studied in order to determine what the amendment actually entails. These notes have no legal status.

<i>Provision</i>	<i>Note</i>
General Note K paragraph 6	The effect of this amendment is that as the Republic of Madagascar has submitted their Instrument of Implementation and shall implement the Protocol on Trade in the Southern African Development Community (SADC) with retrospective effect from 1 October 2007 , goods imported from Madagascar shall be liable to the SADC rate of duty.
