ADHERING TO INFRASTRUCTURAL SET UP GUIDELINES FOR CONNECT DIRECT™ SECURE + IN PRODUCTION

We would like to thank all third party data suppliers for participating in the testing process by preparing the supporting and retrospective data associated with your Dividends Tax Return (DTR02) submissions. We would also like to remind you that you have until 1 March 2013 to submit your retrospective data for dividends tax to SARS.

We would like to bring two matters to your attention:

1. The use of Secure+ in Trade Testing and Production

Third party data suppliers need to comply to the SARS security standard for the Connect:Direct™ bulk submission channel. The standard for this channel which provides secure communication and transactions is IBM™ Sterling Connect:Direct™ Secure+.

Please note that we are only providing access to Connect:Direct™ via a link into the SARS MPLS at Internet Solutions. Detail on this standard is available on the SARS website www.sars.gov.za.

2. The Production Process must be activated by yourself using the following steps below:

STEP 2	Company confirms third party Link: Multi Protocol Label Switching (MPLS) through the Service Provider: Internet Solutions is online	Client/ submitting entity
STEP 3	Company must provide SARS with their Node Name, Source IP and Port details (for SARS to open up their fire wall). SARS will provide the SARS Node Name, Source IP and Port details to the company.	Client/ submitting entity & SARS
STEP 4	Company enrols and activates on eFiling in Production. Company needs to enrol and activate to register for use of Connect: Direct™ and also to receive an encrypted digital	Client/ submitting entity

STEP 5	SARS grants the firewall access to submitting parties.	SARS
STEP 6	SARS informs Company of the completeness of the set-up process and the readiness to submit files, in Production.	SARS
STEP 7	Company starts submitting files via Connect:Direct™ in Production	Client/ submitting entity
