SUBJECT: REGULATION OF WOOD PACKAGING MATERIAL IN INTERNATIONAL TRADE

The Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (DAFF) have requested SARS to inform exporters, importers and all other role players involved in the international trading of products involving wood-packaging material, to comply with International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures (ISPM) No. 15.

Wood originating from living or dead trees may be infested by pests. Wood packaging material is frequently made of raw wood that may not have undergone sufficient processing or treatment to remove or kill pests and therefore remains a pathway for the introduction and spread of quarantine pests. Exporters, importers and all other role players involved in wood-packaging material should adhere to the requirement as stipulated in ISPM No.15.
