Dear Member of the Diplomatic Community

SARS has recently observed that certain embassies are not always in possession of a valid tax invoice when claiming their VAT refund.

We therefore wish to highlight the requirements of a valid tax invoice. The following information must be present on a tax invoice:

Full Tax invoice (where the consideration for the supply is R5 000 or more)	Abridged Tax invoice (where the consideration for the supply is less than R5 000)
The words "TAX INVOICE", "VAT INVOICE" or "INVOICE" in a prominent place;	The words "TAX INVOICE", "VAT INVOICE" or "INVOICE" in a prominent place;
Name, address and VAT registration number of the supplier;	Name, address and VAT registration number of the supplier;
Name, address and VAT registration number of recipient; Serial number and date of issue;	Serial number and date of issue;
Full and proper description of the goods and/or services;	A description of the goods and/or services;
Quantity or volume of goods or services supplied; Value & amount of VAT	Value & amount of VAT

Please note that with effect from 1 April 2015, SARS will be disallowing claims where the above requirements have not been satisfied in full.

The additional words 'VAT INVOICE' and 'INVOICE' were effective from 8 January 2016.
